1 Vancouver ~ Merritt ~ Fraser Valley ~ VQA Winery ~ Kelowna ~ Revelstoke
Depart Vancouver early in the morning, pass through Fraser Valley towards Kelowna - a well-known city for its fruit orchards with cherries & peaches. On the way you can see the famous Okanagan Lake and learn the story of the legendary lake monster "Ogopogo". Tour stops by a famous VQA Winery, learn about the basics of wine making and enjoy tasting for free. Popular ice wine, red & white wine are available for purchase.
Hotel: Sandman / Coast Hillcrest Revelstoke or similar (L/D)

2 Roger Pass ~ Yoho National Park ~ Lake Louise ~ Moraine Lake ~ Bow Fall ~ Banff
Visit the Roger's Pass - a high mountain pass through the Selkirk Mountains of British Columbia used by the Canadian Pacific Railway and the Trans-Canada Highway. Pass through the Yoho National Park and arrive Lake Louise. You will be impressed by the panoramic view of the "Jewel of the Rockies". Continue to Moraine Lake (open from Jun to mid Oct, subject to change), which consider one of the most valuable photography places. Its blue-green waters are sheltered in the Valley of the Ten Peaks. Afterward we visit the Bow River where Marilyn Monroe filmed the 1953 "River of No Return". Later we take the Banff Gondola (optional) up the top of the Sulphur Mountain. Tonight, free at leisure in Banff Town with all the shops and restaurants.
Hotel: Canalta Lodge / High Country Inn Banff or similar (B/L)

3 Banff ~ Icefields Parkway ~ Crowfoot Glacier ~ Bow Lake ~ Jasper National Park ~ Columbia Icefield ~ Peyto Lake ~ Natural Bridge
Take a scenic drive on Icefields Parkway to Jasper National Park. Pass through the Crow-foot Glacier and the Bow Lake. Arrive the Columbia Icefield, which has an area of 325sq.km and 250m in depth, take a ride on the Ice Explorer (optional) to discover the power of nature in the Athabasca Glacier. You can join the Skywalk experience (optional) on a glass-floored walkway at 280m high, extending over the Sunwapta Valley. A bird's eye view provides the most unique perspective of nature at its finest. Afterward we visit the Peyto Lake (opening time are subject to change), a stunning turquoise-colored lake fed by Peyto Glacier. Continue our journey to Yoho Nation Park and visit the Natural Bridge, sculpted by the erosive forces of rushing water over what had once been a waterfall, a powerful reminder of how much influence water has in shaping the landscape.

4 Revelstoke ~ Last Spike ~ Kamloops ~ Vancouver
We proceed to Craigellachie where the Last Spike was driven into the Canadian Pacific Railway, a symbol of national unity in Canada. Then head to Kamloops, We will visit a Ginseng farm and production factory to learn about the power of Ginseng while enjoying a cup of ginseng tea. Return to Vancouver in the late afternoon. (B/L)
